WHY INVEST IN ARKF ?

- 1 Exposure To Innovation:** Aims for thematic exposure to "Space Exploration", including orbital and sub-orbital aerospace, enabling technologies, and beneficiaries of aerospace activities, such as agriculture, Internet access, global positioning system (GPS), construction, and imaging.1
- 2 Growth Potential:** Aims to capture long-term growth with low correlation of relative returns to traditional growth strategies.
- 3 Tools For Diversification:** Offers a tool for diversification due to little overlap with traditional indices. It can be a complement to traditional value/growth strategies.
- 4 Grounded In Research :** Combines top-down and bottom-up research in its portfolio management to identify innovative companies and convergence across markets.
- 5 Cost Effective:** Provides a lower cost alternative to mutual funds with true active management in an Exchange Traded Fund (ETF) that invests in rapidly moving themes.
